ACCEPTABLE MERCHANDISE

Thank you for considering the White Rock South Surrey Hospice Society Thrift Store for donating your goods. Please be aware we sell only merchandise that is in good (saleable) condition, clean, intact (all pieces/parts, e.g. puzzles, games, mechanical and electrical items), in working order (e.g. electrical or mechanical items) & items not chipped, broken, rusted, or torn.

Sorted goods in smaller bags or boxes appreciated!

- Appliances, small: like irons, kettles, coffee makers, blenders, food processors, grills, warmers, toasters, radios, electric knives, etc. – in working order
- Bath towels, hand towels, face cloths, cosmetic bags, bath mats, shower curtains/rings in good condition; bath products new and unopened
- Books, except encyclopedias, condensed books and textbooks; CD's, videos, DVD's,
- Canes, crutches, walkers, bath some other health aids - inquire
- Clothing; women's, men's, youth, children and infants; clean, no stains or pilling
- Collectible ornamental pieces, china and other antiques.
- DVD players (see over), traditional telephones, some other electronics - see over and call
- Pocket rods or rods that take tab-top curtains or curtains with rings.
- Décor items including Christmas, home accessories, rugs/carpets in good condition and clean
- Fabric and craft items; new stationary and paper items, albums, etc.
- Furniture: smaller pieces like chairs, love seats, desks, tables, dressers, shelving units, and some head/foot boards. Some antiques. Call ahead regarding any furniture donation: 604-538-7600
- Jewellery – good costume, designer and collectible
- Kitchen wares, glassware, tableware, baskets; canning jars May – October.
- Lamps, lighting – selective: intact, all parts, working order; lamp shapes – clean only
- Linens, laundered, no stains: sheets, blankets, bedspreads, duvets, duvet covers, decorator pillows, table linens
- Luggage –pieces up to carry on size with wheels; backpacks, gym and tote bags
- Mirrors with frames or without, no chips or cracks
- Magazines: selected titles only – please call.
- Pictures, paintings, hangings, picture frames, in good condition only
- Purses, briefcases, computer carrying cases, computer carrying cases, folios, wallets
- Puzzles, games, some larger toys and medium to large stuffed animals that are clean and in good condition (we are very selective)
- Shelves, shelving and other storage items; no large entertainment units
- Shoes, sandals, slippers, boots, belts
- Sports gear – skates, newer golf equipment, balls, small bikes

From time to time, when we are overstocked on items that are normally acceptable, we will temporarily limit or discontinue the intake of these items.

From time to time, when the stock room is at capacity for goods, we will close the donations department for an interim period. Please call ahead.

There will be interim periods when we are not accepting out-of-season clothing.

MERCHANDISE WE DO NOT ACCEPT

- Baby strollers, cribs, car seats, etc.
- Bikes other than small children's;
- Christmas lights - except newer, LCD's preferably boxed
- Electronics like: microwaves, TV's, stereos, VCR's, computers, printers, copiers, etc. (some exceptions – call); DVD players accepted if working - portables must have adaptors. Some exceptions for smaller colour TV's and microwaves and VCR's, call
- Encyclopedia sets, condensed books and textbooks
- Food items
- Cassette audio tapes, home-made VHS videos
- Household cleaners/chemicals/pesticides and paint
- Larger appliances
- Larger furniture accepted by appointment only: call 604 538 7600 to check
- Large tools like those for plumbing and gardening including lawn mowers
- Magazines – some exceptions call to inquire
- Mattresses, box springs, hide-a-beds, futons, beds, sleeping pillows
- Medium to large pieces of luggage (some exceptions – call
- Out-of- season clothing only accepted during specific periods
- Roller blades
- Skis, ski boots unless they are very recent technology
- Small toys and small stuffed animals
- Sewing machines, typewriters, battery operated portable telephones unless battery working
- Venetian or vertical blinds, custom made drapes, drapery hardware except pocket rods or rods for tabs top curtains or curtains with rings.
